HORIZON EUROPE PROGRAMME

This newsletter provides a selection of the latest calls and its requirements around the **Horizon Europe Programme**. The aim is to provide periodic updates and synthesize relevant information on the open calls regarding the fields addressed by this programme.

Horizon Europe Programme is the EU's research and innovation programme for 2021-2027 with a budget of €95,5 billion. The programme facilitates collaboration and strengthens the impact of research and innovation in developing, supporting and implementing EU policies while tackling global challenges. It supports creating and better dispersing of excellent knowledge and technologies.

DIGITAL & AUTOMATED UP TO AUTONOMOUS TRAIN OPERATIONS

Deadline: 23 June 2022 17:00 Brussels time.

Description: A major opportunity is offered by digitalization and automation of rail operation, where DATO (Digital "Automated" Train Operations) represents the most visible result of a major transformation of rail operations, which builds upon a next generation of Automatic Train Control (ATC), in addition to enhancements on the Train Control and Monitoring System (TCMS) allowing for integration at the on-board level. The aim of this destination is to take the major opportunity offered by digitalization and automation of rail operation and to develop the Next Generation ATC and deliver scalable automation in train operations, up to GoA4. Project duration: 48 months.

Project budget: EUR 54 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Natural persons, international organisations, entities without legal personality and EU bodies **are not eligible**.
- Be established in one of the eligible countries (EU MS or EEA countries).

Specific requirements:

- Proposals must be submitted by candidates with Expertise from rail infrastructure managers and railway undertakings.
- Applicants must have stable and sufficient resources to successfully implement the projects.

SUSTAINABLE COMPETITIVE DIGITAL GREEN RAIL FREIGHT SERVICES

Deadline: 23 June 2022 17:00 Brussels time.

Description: The objective is to make rail freight more attractive through better services to the European supply chain by the following threefold: Increasing capacity in a smart way for all types of rail freight transport (e.g.

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with Digital Automatic Coupler (DAC) and other technological and operational solutions), Improving cross-border operation (cross border implies an important share of freight traffic and it expected to grow) and finally a better multimodal service offering. In addition to all these, this destination aims to contribute, if necessary, in the delivery of harmonization by means of contributing on the definition of European Standards. Project duration: 48 months.

Project budget: EUR 42 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Natural persons, international organisations, entities without legal personality and EU bodies **are not eligible**.
- Be established in one of the eligible countries (EU MS or EEA countries).

Specific requirements:

- Expertise from rail infrastructure managers and railway undertakings.
- Applicants must have stable and sufficient resources to successfully implement the projects.

INTELLIGENT & INTEGRATED ASSET MANAGEMENT

Deadline: 23 June 2022 17:00 Brussels time.

Description: In the vision of the future rail asset management, assets status evolution information will be integrated with TMS (Traffic Management System) to improve services, reducing unavailability by limiting the impact of in-service failures and/or providing alternative solutions without cost impacts, and increasing safety. Moreover, the available information combined with AI (Artificial Intelligence) and digital twins will introduce intelligence to the management and optimize the overall life cycle and operation of the rail system. Project duration: 48 months.

Project budget: EUR 43 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Natural persons, international organisations, entities without legal personality and EU bodies **are not eligible**.
- Be established in one of the eligible countries (EU MS or EEA countries).

Specific requirements:

- Expertise from rail infrastructure managers and railway undertakings and from rail suppliers.

EIC TRANSITION CHALLENGE: PROCESS AND SYSTEM INTEGRATION OF CLEAN ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES

Deadline- 28 September 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: further develop energy technologies, including renewable fuels enabling the decarbonisation of energy sector. For further information, please check the [Call document](#) (page 56 onwards).

Project duration: 3 years.

Project budget: EUR 500,000 - EUR 2 million.

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Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Legal entities established in Russia, Belarus, or in non-government controlled territories of Ukraine **are not eligible**.
- Be established in one of the eligible countries, i.e.: – EU Member States (including overseas countries and territories (OCTs)).

Specific requirements:

- For **multi-beneficiary proposals** (3 different countries): must include at least one legal entity established in an EU member state and two legal entities established in two other EU member states or associated countries.
- For **two-beneficiary proposals** (2 different countries): two independent legal entities from two different EU member state or associated countries.
- For **mono-beneficiary proposals**: one legal entity established in an EU member state or candidate associated country.

IMPLEMENTING CO-FUNDED ACTION PLANS FOR INTERCONNECTION OF INNOVATION ECOSYSTEMS

Deadline- 27 September 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: Enhanced synergies, complementarities and collaboration among all European innovation ecosystems' stakeholders around promising areas and challenges of joint and European interest, creation of common knowledge assets. Project duration: 5 years.

Project budget: EUR 2 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Legal entities established in Russia, Belarus, or in non-government controlled territories of Ukraine **are not eligible**.
- Be established in one of the eligible countries, i.e.: – EU Member States (including overseas countries and territories (OCTs)).

Specific requirements:

- Consortia must have at **least three (3) independent legal entities**.
- Applicants must ensure their **long-term commitment** towards engaging in the joint cooperation activities set up in the frame of their projects.

INCREASED FORESIGHT CAPACITY FOR SECURITY

Deadline- 23 November 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: providing an increased knowledge base on technology foresight, more accessible to the security stakeholders, that supports the consolidation of a forward-looking culture in the planning and use of resources in security. Project duration: 3 years.

Project budget: EUR 1.5 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Legal entities established in Russia, Belarus, or in non-government controlled territories of Ukraine **are not eligible**.

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- Be established in one of the eligible countries, i.e.: – EU Member States (including overseas countries and territories (OCTs)).

Specific requirements:

- The proposals should take into account existing foresight approaches implemented by other EU and international organizations.
- Applicants must show a good understanding of the context where security research and capacity building programming takes place (mostly at EU level).

GREENOFFSHORETECH - 1ST OPEN CALL FOR APPLICANTS

Deadline- 6 July 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: Innovative technologies to support the capture, storage and transportation of energy to the end user. Decarbonisation and modernisation of waterborne transport products, services and fleets. For further information, please check the [official website](#).

Project duration: 11 months.

Project budget: EUR 60.000 per project.

Eligible criteria:

- SMEs (Small and Medium-size Enterprise) according to the EU definition (including start-ups, young companies, Public SMEs).
- Applicants must be legal entities established and based in one of the GreenOffshoreTech regions in Latvia, Poland, Portugal, Germany, Norway, Iceland, and UK or members of one of the GreenOffshoreTech clusters.

Specific requirements:

- Applicants must be technology providers or technology adopters/users focusing on following Key Enabling Technologies: **advanced materials, advanced manufacturing, Industry 4.0/digital technologies, environmental technologies.**
- Applicants must have not been declared **bankrupt** or have initiated **bankruptcy procedures**.

EHDEN DATA PARTNER CALL 6

Deadline- 14 June 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: The EHDEN project aims to collaborate with diverse institutions, data sources and data custodians across the EU, with a goal of harmonising source data to the OMOP common data model locally, within a federated network. For further information, please check the [Call document](#).

Project duration: 12 months.

Project budget: EUR 2 Million.

Eligible criteria:

- The Data Partner is the legitimate custodian of longitudinal, person-level observational health data of one of the following data source types: **Electronic, Health Records, Claims, Hospital or Registry.**
- Applications from countries not yet (or minimally) represented in the **EHDEN Network** will be especially welcome.

Specific requirements:

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- Specific interest for this call (but not exclusively): monitoring vaccine use, safety and effectiveness in the public health emergency setting (e.g. COVID-19) and in routine healthcare (for all existing and novel vaccines, rare/autoimmune/inflammatory diseases, neurology, oncology and medical devices).

DIRECT COMBUSTION OF HYDROGEN IN AERO-ENGINES

Deadline- 23 June 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: Strengthen the synergies between the Clean Aviation JU and Member States/associated countries/regions that have an aviation policy to contribute towards the target of the climate neutral aviation by 2050. For further information, please check the [Call document](#) (page 5 onwards).

Project duration: 36 months.

Project budget: EUR 115 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Legal entities established in Russia, Belarus, or in non-government controlled territories of Ukraine **are not eligible**.
- Applicants shall also be able to demonstrate the link(s) with the national/regional policies related to Clean Aviation programme, as well as the ability to exchange with the relevant competent national and/or regional authorities.

Specific requirements:

- In coordination with the States Representatives Group, establishing a networking platform consisting of all the interested and involved parties, including the **National Contact Points (NCPs)**.

NOVEL CERTIFICATION METHODS AND MEANS OF COMPLIANCE OF DISRUPTIVE TECHNOLOGIES

Deadline- 23 June 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: Development of processes and methods to prepare the future certification framework, based on the analysis of risks and gaps of existing regulations, and implemented on a set of critical challenges representative of disruptive technologies and architectures. Project duration: 48 months.

Project budget: EUR 18 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Legal entities established in Russia, Belarus, or in non-government controlled territories of Ukraine **are not eligible**.

Specific requirements:

- Applicants must provide a **clear roadmap** (aligned with the SRIA and with the objectives as defined in the Work Programme) that can support certification of new aircraft with an entry into service no later than 2035.
- Ensure the proposal is aligned with the Gantt chart(s) of the relevant thrust(s) as published in the Clean Aviation Work Programme 2022-2023.

NGI ASSURE 9TH OPEN CALL

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Deadline- 1 June 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: The goal of NGI Assure is to support projects that design and engineer reusable building blocks for the Next Generation Internet as part of a complete, strong chain of assurances for all stakeholders regarding the source and integrity of identities, identifiers, data, cyberphysical systems, service components and processes. Project duration: 1-12 months.

Project budget: EUR 50,000.

Eligible criteria:

- Natural person, legal entities or organisations of any type that wants to improve and further develop Distributed Ledger Technologies.
- Applicants from Europe are given priority.

Specific requirements:

- Entities that are under liquidation or are an enterprise under difficulty according to the Commission Regulation No 651/2014, art. 2.18 are not accepted.
- Either those that are excluded from the possibility of obtaining EU funding under the provisions of both national and EU law, or by a decision of both national or EU authority.

DEVELOPING A EUROPEAN CLEAN AVIATION REGIONAL ECOSYSTEM (ECARE)

Deadline- 23 June 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time.

Description: Establish a networking platform that will facilitate the interaction between the national and regional stakeholders (including clusters) and identify specific measures aimed at increasing the involvement of SMEs and other stakeholders in the Clean Aviation programme. Project duration: 36 months.

Project budget: EUR 720,000.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Legal entities established in Russia, Belarus, or in non-government controlled territories of Ukraine **are not eligible**.
- Applicants shall also be able to demonstrate the link(s) with the national/regional policies related to Clean Aviation programme, as well as the ability to exchange with the relevant competent national and/or regional authorities.

Specific requirements:

- In coordination with the States Representatives Group, establishing a networking platform consisting of all the interested and involved parties, including the **National Contact Points (NCPs)**.

DESIGNING INCLUSIVE, SAFE, AFFORDABLE AND SUSTAINABLE URBAN MOBILITY

Deadline: 21 September 2022 17:00 Brussels time.

Description: The objective is to contribute to the objectives of the Climate Neutral and Smart Cities Mission by accelerating the transition towards climate neutrality in cities through the promotion of zero-emission, shared,

Project budget: EUR 40 million.

Eligible criteria:

- Legal entities (public or private bodies). Natural persons, international organisations, entities without legal personality and EU bodies **are not eligible**.

- Applicants must have stable and sufficient resources to successfully implement the projects.

Specific requirements:

- The page limit of the application is 70 pages.
