### HORIZON EUROPE PROGRAMME

This newsletter provides a selection of the latest calls and its requirements around the **Horizon Europe Programme**. The aim is to provide periodic updates and synthetize relevant information on the open calls regarding the fields addressed by this programme.

**Horizon Europe Programme** is the EU's research and innovation programme for 2021-2027 with a budget of €95,5 billion. The programme facilitates collaboration and strengthens the impact of research and innovation in developing, supporting and implementing EU policies while tackling global challenges. It supports creating and better dispersing of excellent knowledge and technologies.

### **DIGITAL & AUTOMATED UP TO AUTONOMOUS TRAIN OPERATIONS**

Deadline: 23 June 2022 17:00 Brussels time.

**Description:** A major opportunity is offered by digitalization and automation of rail operation, where DATO (Digital "Automated" Train Operations) represents the most visible result of a major transformation of rail operations, which builds upon a next generation of Automatic Train Control (ATC), in addition to enhancements on the Train Control and Monitoring System (TCMS) allowing for integration at the on-board level. The aim of this destination is to take the major opportunity offered by digitalization and automation of rail operation and to develop the Next Generation ATC and deliver scalable automation in train operations, up to GoA4.
